### **WRANGELL ST. ELIAS NATIONAL PARK**

The Wrangell St. Elias National Park is located in south-central Alaska, approximately 200 miles east of Anchorage and is accessible by road or chartered air service. Its Alaska's largest National Park and is recognized as a World Heritage Site by the international community. Wrangell St. Elias National Park has a very limited maintained trail system and is for the most part true wilderness. Many of our hiking tours require chartered bush flights to reach the more remote destinations. You will follow ancient game trails, explore tundra covered ridges and plateaus, hike on glaciers or trek up into the clouds to experience some of the tallest mountains in North America. The views from these mountains passes rival anything we have ever seen in Alaska. These tours are perfect for the family, photographer or the hard core hiking enthusiast.
