### **Prince William Sound**

Prince William Sound is Alaska's premier kayaking destination! Located 1 hour south of Anchorage this vast, undeveloped collection of beautiful fjords is sheltered from the open Pacific ocean by large barrier islands. Combine this protection with the mild weather patterns found during the summer and you have an exceptional sea kayaking destination in Alaska.

### **Wrangell St.-Elias National Park**

Located in south central Alaska, the Wrangell St.-Elias National Park is Alaska's largest National Park. We offer a unique fly-out sea kayaking trip to the remote fjord of Icy Bay, located on the North Gulf Coast of Alaska. Massive calving glaciers, thundering waterfalls and the towering 18,000 ft. Mt. Saint Elias characterize Icy Bay. We also explore the Bering glacier region of the North Gulf Coast of Alaska which offers paddling on Vitus Lake, a sheltered lake at the base of one of the largest glaciers in Alaska. You'll paddle among massive ice bergs while the abundant harbor seal population takes a curious look at you. There are incredible glacier hikes and many wonderful land hikes as well. Definitely one of our favorite lake kayaking destinations in Alaska.
