Yukon Quest Sled Dog Race

The Yukon Quest is a 1,000-mile sled dog race between Fairbanks, Alaska and Whitehorse, located in the Yukon Territory. The race is known as "The Toughest Race in the World". Indeed nearly a third of all the mushers may fail to reach the finish line of this difficult sled dog race. The trail follows the route used in the 1898 gold rush to the Klondike that occurred along the US / Canadian border. You'll visit the turn of the century gold rush capital of Dawson and experience the race there. But that's not all! This exceptional tour combines two other gems found in Alaska - Denali National Park and Chena Hot Springs! We'll take a trip to see the "Great One", Denali, which is the tallest mountain in North America and we'll watch for the Northern Lights from the outdoor pools found at the Chena Hot Springs! Your guide will conduct a photo workshop on capturing the Northern Lights with film. This exceptional guided tour provides all your lodging, transportation and activities. Meals are not included.
